
GET YOUR EXPERIENCE RECOGNISED.

Gain a professional qualification to recognise the skills you're learning on the job anyway – and open up opportunities for greater responsibility and pay in the future.



HOW DOES A BCITO MANAGED APPRENTICESHIP WORK?

Your employer will train you on the job. They'll ensure your work is up to standard, and that you cover the required scope of work to complete the qualification.

You'll also receive a set of workbooks with modules related to your practical work onsite. You can gather and show evidence of your skills and knowledge through your day-to-day work activities. You will be assigned a BCITO Training Advisor who will support and guide you through the qualification and conduct the assessments.



There's never been a better time than right now to start an apprenticeship. The New Zealand Certificate in Trowel Trades – Floor & Wall Tiling Level 4 is an eligible qualification where you could have your first 2 years of training fees paid by the Government.
